# The Sagamore



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SITUATED ON LAKE GEORGE in the heart of the Adirondack Mountains, The Sagamore unfolds across a private island, 70-acre Green Island, with lush landscaping, quiet gardens, and a white-sand beach. Guests come for the seclusion, the stunning views, and the abundance of nature-based activities at the resort's doorstep.

During the summer, the lake takes center stage, with guests enjoying an array of water sports and the private beach. The Sagamore offers its patrons the chance to sign up for sailing instruction at its Offshore Sailing School, where they can set sail in a high-performance Colgate 26.

The par-70, 18-hole championship golf course by Donald Ross, an early master of golf design, provides championship play from spring to fall and

cross-country skiing in winter. A free shuttle to Gore Mountain gives skiers access to downhill slopes. Indoor pursuits throughout the year include pampering visits to the spa and workouts at the health club.

The choice of accommodations begins with the 100-room Historic Hotel, originally built in 1883 and decorated in a colonial-revival style to match the hotel's classic architecture. The six-bedroom Wapanak Castle, listed on the National Register of Historic Places, features five gas-log fireplaces, a large modern kitchen and dining room, and a formal living room. Other options include the Adirondack-style Lodges on the lake's rim and condominiums for short-term rental.

For dining, *The Morgan*, a replica of a nine-

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teenth-century touring vessel, invites guests to embark on a lunch or dinner cruise around the lake. Other dining options include the Trillium bis, The Club Grill overlooking the golf course, the glass-enclosed Veranda with panoramic views of Lake George, and Mister Brown's for casual and pub-style fare.

Business and pleasure mix seamlessly at The Sagamore, where 25,000 square feet of flexible meeting and function space in three locations awaits the meeting professional. The Historic Hotel contains six meeting rooms. The Hermitage, a former carriage house turned lakeside executive retreat, houses two private meeting rooms. And the state-of-the-art Conference Center boasts a ballroom with more than 10,800 square feet of space.

Whether traveling for work or play, everyone benefits from the resort's private-island seclusion, where the pressures of everyday life give way to lakeside tranquility. 🌊
